Instructions

Applicants are required to:

1. Submit this completed and signed application in person or online by March 22, 2024 including:

- Applicant/Parent/Guardian/Teacher Contact information page 2
- Artwork Release form pages 3-4
- Artwork Submission form page 5
- Written recommendation from a teacher
- Paperwork can be submitted in one of the following ways:

 - completed and emailed to hello@elkocountyarts.org [subject line – 2024 Scholarship]

2. Submit their art appropriately mounted or secured on Wednesday, March 27 at the Elko County Art Club Gallery, 407 Railroad Street, Elko, NV between 10 am-6 pm. (A representative for the applicant can submit their artwork.)

3. Pickup their artwork following the exhibition at the Elko County Art Club Gallery, 407 Railroad Street, Elko, NV between 10 am-6 pm on May 14, if you need to pick up at a different time call us. (If ECAC is notified in advance a representative for the applicant can retrieve their artwork.)

The Scholarship Recipient is required to:

- Enroll in at least one (1) art class at the selected school.
- Provide EC Art Club's Treasurer with the selected school's student scholarship department contact information, and
- A copy of the students upcoming class schedule.

3. Students are strongly advised to attend and parents/guardians, friends and teachers are invited to attend the reception.
4. Each Applicant will receive an ECAC membership for a year.
5. Schools can include university, college, technical school or other continuing education.
6. A check will be sent to the school on behalf of the student, to be used for tuition, books and supplies, once the student provides the information requested above.
